

Director for Scotland – Vacancy

An election will be held for the role of CAMRA Director for Scotland in February 2026.

Nominations are now being accepted for any member interested in this role with a deadline date of 1st November (date of the Scotland Regional Meeting) by the Election Administrator, Lindsay Grant: secretary@scotb.camra.org.uk

Nominations

Interested parties will ideally reside in a branch within Scotland, however the National Executive can allow a candidate who lives outside the region to be nominated and stand. Interested parties should then send their nomination (an indication that they are willing to stand with the signature of a proposer and seconder who are CAMRA members from different branches within Scotland) to the Administrator along with a short biography about themselves and why they feel they should have the position of Scotland Director.
