In this role, you'll play a key liaison role between the Local Organising Committee (LOC), CAMRA staff and the host venue to drive continuous improvement for the event.

Key activities include:

- Chairing the MW Visionary Group.
- Reporting into the Events Committee.
- Defining a high-level vision for the delivery of Members' Weekend.
- Empowering, and supporting, the LOC (including the Volunteer Support Manager) to deliver the event against agreed specifications.
- Working closely with the Volunteer Support Manager to research future MW venues.
- Facilitating the handover of one LOC to the next.
- Attending the Members' Weekend itself.

The role does *not* include the day-to-day organisation and running of the event, which is handled by the LOC and CAMRA staff.

Time commitment

Over a year, we expect this role to take approximately 2-4 hours per month. This includes attending virtual meetings.

- Access to the internet, tablet/laptop with camera and good working knowledge of Microsoft Office, particularly Teams.
- A passion for helping Members' Weekend grow as a modern, engaging and continuously evolving event.
